TERMS OF SALE  
(Please Read Carefully)

1. BIDS BY MAIL or PHONE will be accepted until the closing date. All phone bids must be confirmed in writing on a bid sheet. Bids are treated as LIMITS. Bids are reduced where competition permits to within 10% of the second highest bid. In the case of tie bids, the first received is normally given preference. No "buy" or unlimited bids are accepted. Bids are accepted by lot number only. No lots are broken up. Bids are only executed in even dollar amounts.
2. This sale is NOT an approval sale. All material offered is guaranteed genuine and as described. Careful examination has been made of every lot by experts. Cataloging errors will be cheerfully and promptly corrected. FLOOR BIDDERS MAY NOT RETURN ANY LOTS including those purchased while acting as agents. All claims for adjustment by other bidders must be made within five days of receipt but in no case more than 28 days after a sale. As the auction house acts as an agent for various consignors, NO CLAIMS OF ANY KIND can be considered after settlements have been made. If a claim is not made within this 28 day period, no lots are returnable for any reason at any time. If we are notified prior to our settlement date that an opinion of condition, alteration or authenticity is being sought, the matter will remain open until such opinion is rendered. Lots are not shipped until paid for. Therefore, late payment will negate a return privilege. Any returned lot must be in its original holder with seal intact.
3. Successful bidders are required to pay the full invoice amount before lots are delivered. Previously established lines of credit, at the sole option of the auctioneer, may not be honored unless arrangements for this sale have been specifically agreed to in writing by the auctioneer. The next three notes are from the  
Betts Cove Mining Company;

In 1864 copper was discovered  
at Tilt Cove, by an English  
geologist named Smith McKay.  
This led to a rapid develop-  
ment of mining operations at  
Notre Dame Bay. With the  
establishment of several mines  
between 1864 & 1879. The larg-  
est & most profitable mine  
was Betts Cove. It opened in  
1875 under the name of Betts  
Cove Mining Co., & closed in  
1883.

McKay's financial backer was  
C.F. Bennett, Premier of the  
Colony from 1870 to 1874.  
The mine workers were paid by  
means of script, redeemable in  
merchandise at the company  
stores.  
Each of the notes bears one or  
more shields on which are depic-  
ted the smelter where the ore  
was partially refined prior to  
shipment.
