

INTRODUCTION

Our Summer Torex Auction features the second part of the personal collection of J.Lloyd Carney.

Lloyd first began collecting coins in 1940. At that time his principal means of employment was from a taxi business which he ran in the City of Toronto. One must wonder which avenue received the most of his intentions, his hobby or the taxi business. In 1962 Lloyd sold the taxi business and he and his late wife Maisie hit the convention trail. All across the United States and Canada they became familiar sights at coin shows including all of the CNA and ANA conventions from 1960 to 1982. Lloyd is a member of each of the CNA and ANA.

Lloyd never lost that collector's delight in uncovering a needed coin for his collection nor in the appreciation of those scarce and rare coins, tokens and paper money that make up the Canadian series. Over the past thirty years only the best of thousands of numismatic items that he dealt in made their way into his personal collection.

The kind of quality and scarcity of items in the J.Lloyd Carney Collection were confirmed earlier this year at the Winter Torex Auction. Many of the auction highlights were examples from the Carney collection. Time and time again pre-auction estimates were shattered as floor and mail bidders competed for these highly prized items. Lot 1085, a Barclay's Bank 1929 \$5.00 sold for \$935.00; Lot 1103, a \$2.00 Commercial Bank of Canada 1860 brought \$1980.00; Lot 1107, the \$20.00 note of the Commercial Bank of Newfoundland, 1888 issue, was knocked down for \$3,080.00, an amount over five times pre-auction estimate! From the token section of this outstanding collection came such rarities as Lot 1259, the Broken Leaf Sou Breton 703. This eventually sold for a record price of \$3,740.00, again nearly five times estimate. Lot 1308, the Nova Scotia Mayflower Halfpenny in Proof, realized \$1.980.00.

These few examples clearly show the kind of quality and rarity of numismatic material that formed part of this important collection. Unquestionably the Lloyd Carney Collection ranks high on the list of quality and rarity for collections formed over the past thirty years. This particular sale offers you another opportunity to acquire items of Canadian numismatic significance.

A small quantity were struck early in the year before it was discovered that the original designs had deteriorated so much that they were no longer useable. A completely new model with noticeably smaller schooner and small date replaced the original designs in early 1969. The Obv is the same as the 11965 to 1968 issues. Struck at the Ottawa Mint.Only 5 to 10pcs are thought to exist. Possibly the rarest of all Canadian circulating coins and certainly the key in the Canadian Ten Cent series. 


ORIGIN OF A BANK NOTE DESIGN by Walter D. Allan

Collectors of bank notes and syngraphists (those who study them as well as other fiscal documents) primarily pay attention to the face of the items where the date, origin and many other essential and important facets of any particular document are found.

It is not surprising then, that one rarely sees an illustration of the back of a note or reads any significant information concerning them. Several important varieties of even Dominion of Canada notes have been discovered or recognized in the last two years (see C.P.M.S. Journals). It is with considerable exhilaration that I am able to shed some interesting information concerning the back design of the Bank of Toronto notes, or more specifically the central medallic portraits represented there.

The Bank of Toronto opened for business, July 8th, 1856 and has earned the reputation of being a sound and trustworthy institution, friendly yet businesslike while pursuing the highest ideals of good banking.

The first bank note issues had no design on the back (except for the denomination overprint the same as on the face). Then a very attractive bright orange back design was added, featuring in the centre a magnificient double portrait of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert in which were incorporated a trident and dolphins symbolizing Britain's sea power.

This design was in fact the same as that used on the obverse of the prize medal given to exhibitors at the Great Exhibition held at the famous Crystal Palace in London, England, which opened on May 1st, 1851 and stayed open until October 15th. During that time over 6 million people passed through the turnstiles.

The obverse of the medal was designed by William Wyon, royal academician and chief engraver of the Royal Mint, who was at that time, possibly the most famous designer of medallions in Europe.

I will speculate that in some manner one of these medals came into the possession of one of the Bank of Toronto directors, and its beauty, apart from any symbolism, was appreciated to the extent, that it was adopted into their bank note design.

It was first engraved by the firm of Rawdon, Wright, Hatch and Edson, New York whose imprint appears on the first issues of the bank notes and also on several proof backs, which I am fortunate enough to have in my collection. In the process the main design of the medal was reversed so that the heads face to the right, rather than to the left as on the medal. Later, after amalgamation, the imprint of the American Bank Note Company appears.

This back design was apparently so well received, that it remained unchanged on the backs of the \$5.00, \$10.00, \$20.00 and \$50.00 issues until the bank stopped issuing notes.

The distinctive and beautiful designs, the bright yellow face and orange back of these denominations of bank notes have made them, possibly, from a visual aspect, the most attractive and sought after notes of any bank by collectors and non collectors alike.

One of the more interesting aspects and one often overlooked is the historical interrelationship between coins, tokens, medals and bank notes. For that extra added enjoyment why not review your collection for these relationships.
