*"The Welland Battery was one of the first corps on the field, and helped to drive the invaders to the Niagara." - McLachlan.*
20. Br. 57. Upper Canada Preserved. Presented by a Greatful Country. For Merit. a.u. \$200.00  
*No originals are known of this medal, but early restrikes in silver and copper were probably made about 1870. Later restrikes in silver, with numbered edges were struck in a quantity of 100 for W.S. Cutts by Messrs. Wyon. These later restrikes are much commoner. The original issue of this medal, when received in 1814, was found to be unsatisfactory by the Loyal and Patriotic Society of Upper Canada, as the Directors disapproved of the lion and beaver being on the left bank, their idea being that the observer should be looking upstream, contrary to the military convention that the observer always looks downstream. The fifty medals that were received were finally destroyed in 1840 along with most of the replacement issue. (Br. 58) PHOTO.*

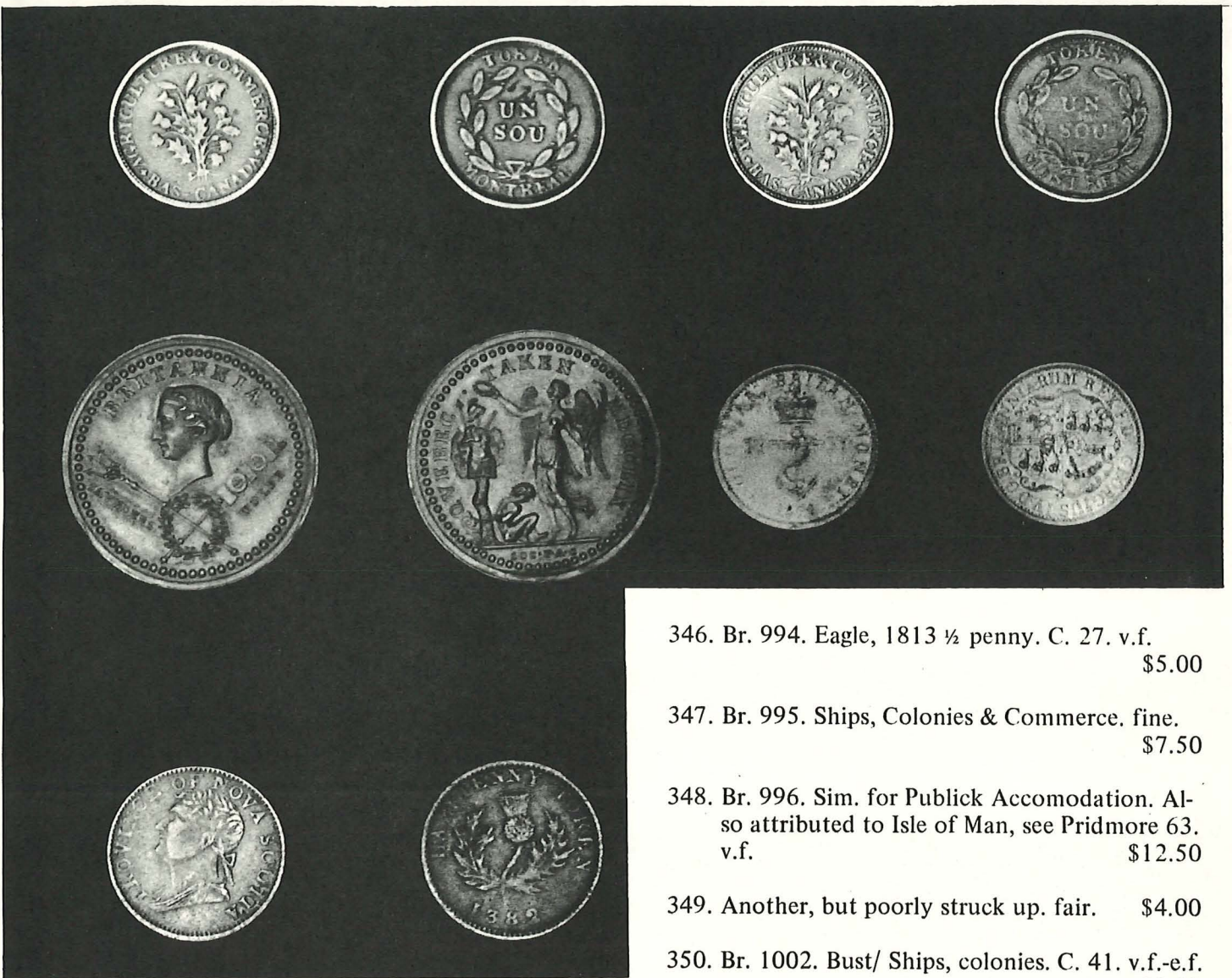
