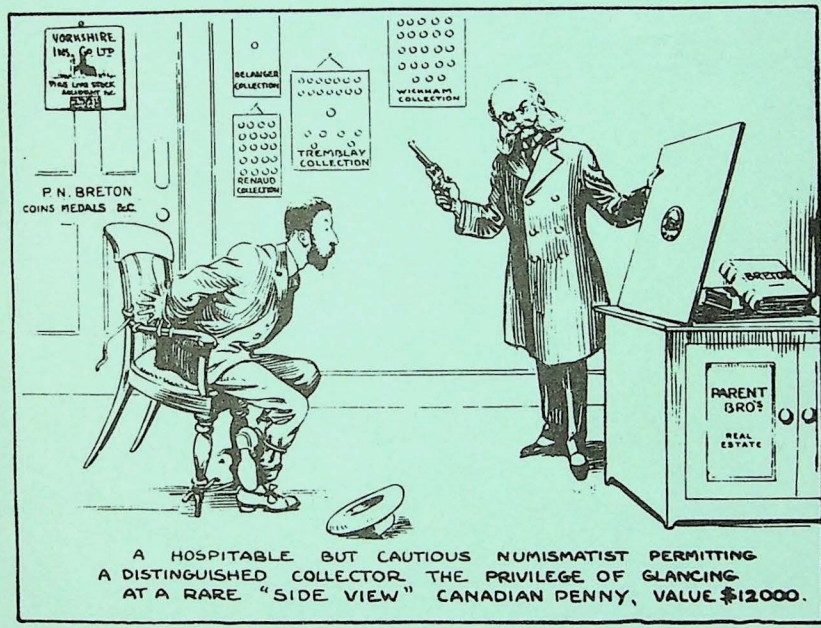

This cartoon was drawn for P.M. Wickham of Montreal by the Mortimer Co. in 1913. The seated and tied figure is Wickham himself; the other caricature is of G.W. Parent, another early Montreal numismatist. Portraits of both men appear in Breton (1912), pp. 65 & 77. Obviously the decimal points were misplaced in the value of the coin, and should read \$120.00. The frames on the wall denote other contemporary Montreal collections and indicate their relative sizes.
