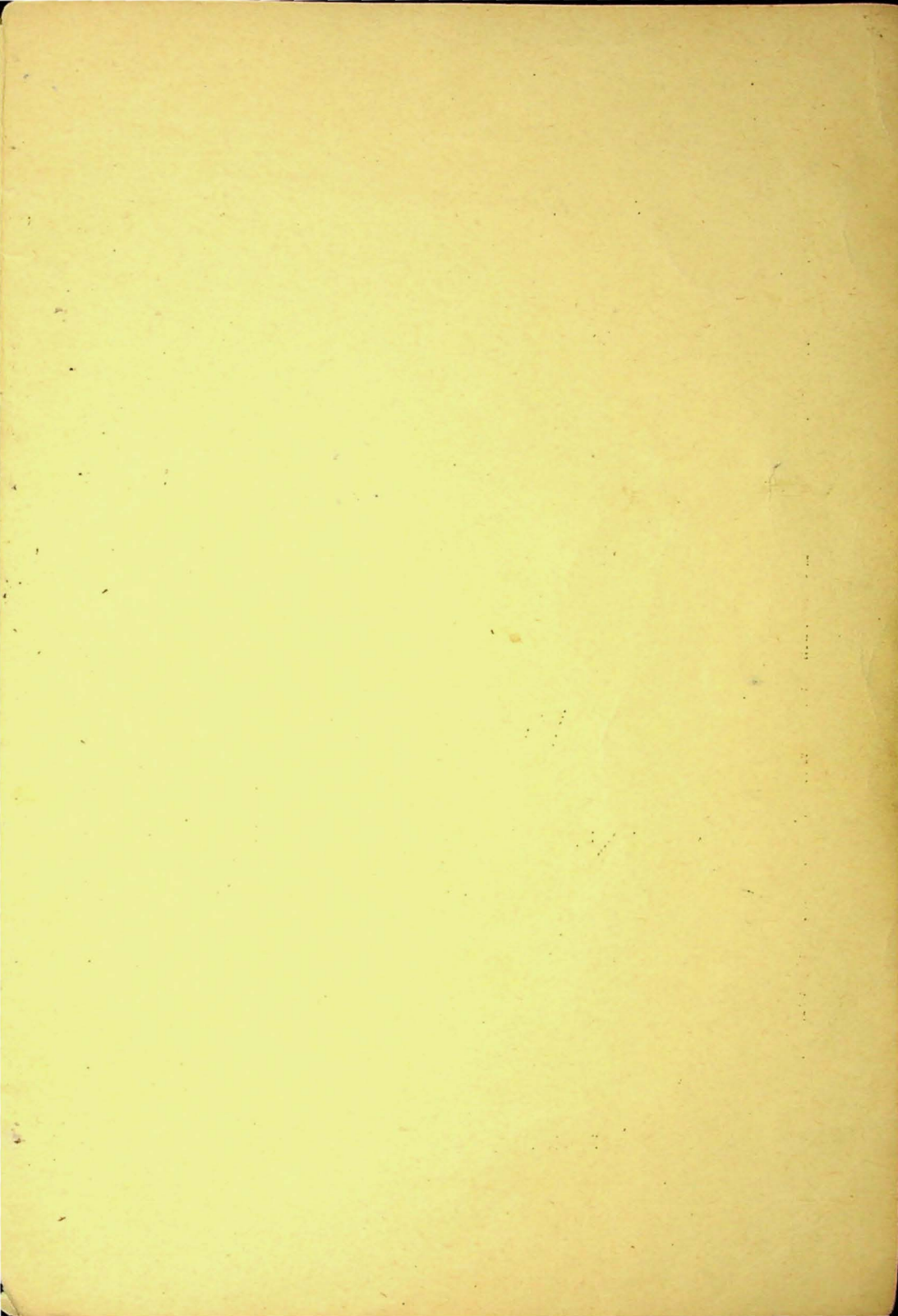

INTRODUCTION

The first edition of this little guide, published in 1937, has been out of print for some time. We are now able to offer a new edition with the added feature of a specialized list of dates. Certain remarks quoted from the first edition still seem to be in order.

This is not a price list. The values given are the retail and auction prices averaged over a period of years. Values given in italics indicate that the coins are seldom offered for sale, past transactions have been made at about these figures.

No attempt has been made to tabulate die varieties. Collectors who are interested in varieties of boquet sous, bank tokens and other pieces are referred to the various publications by Breton, Courteau, and McLachlan. It will be noted that the "Doubtful" series as listed by Breton has been entirely omitted as the tokens bear no reference to Canada, having merely circulated there although struck primarily for speculative use in England and Ireland.

The mint report originally compiled through the courtesy of the Royal Canadian Mint has been extended by further reports.

The arrangement of Canada and Newfoundland has been taken from "Coins of the World" with a slight change in numbering.

The publisher wishes to express appreciation to Mr. J. Douglas Ferguson for his arrangement and scale of values in the specialized list of dates also for other timely suggestions.
