37.	Militia Button. Quebec Militia incused at top, uniform with border. 1775 at bottom, uniform with border. (These buttons when divested of their shanks, circulated as change at a time when copper coinage was somewhat of a scarcity. They were struck for the raw levies in Canada that aided the English in trying to subdue the American War of Independence. McLachlan lists a "Montre al British Militia" button which he claims to have been struck for the War of 1812. Only one other specimen of a Militia button that is identifiable with a place in Canada previous to 1800 is known. This is a possibly unique piece of the "Island of St. John Militia" (P.E.I.).
