## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. Bid by Lot Number, so much per Lot.
2. Unlimited or Buy Bids will not be accepted. We will purchase lots for your account below your maximum bids whenever possible.
3. No commission charged for handling your bids. Only additional charge will be for postage and insurance, and tax, if applicable.
4. Bidders unknown to us should supply suitable references or a deposit equal to 25% of their bids.
5. Terms are cash and payment to be made immediately upon receipt of material or invoice in Canadian funds or the equivalent. We allow the full bank premium on U.S. funds. At present it is 7¾%.
6. All material in this sale is guaranteed genuine, unless stated otherwise, and any errors in cataloguing will be satisfactorily adjusted.
7. Lots will be on exhibition at the Nova Scotian Hotel on the days of the sale.
8. Valuations placed after each lot are only for the guidance of bidders. Selling prices may be higher or lower.
9. The highest bidder to be the buyer. In cases of similar bids, preference will be given to the first received. Bidding advances will be at the discretion of the Auctioneer. If disputes should arise, the Auctioneer's decision will be final.
10. An official list of prices realized will be released approximately three weeks after the sale. The price will be \$1.00. The H mint mark has been omitted in this listing except for years in which coins with and without the H mint mark were issued.

**An asterisk preceding a lot No. indicates that the item is illustrated.**

11. Minors' bids cannot be accepted unless guaranteed by parent or guardian.

Floor bidding will commence at approximately 5% above the second highest mail bid. If there is no floor bid, the highest mail bidder will receive the lot at the opening bid, already mentioned. For example, if the highest mail bid on a certain lot is \$11.00 and the next highest mail bid is \$10.00, the bidding will start at \$10.50. In the event of a floor bid above \$11.00, the highest floor bidder is awarded the lot. Advances in bidding should be at least 5%, and the floor bid must exceed the top mail bid, to be successful.

Mail bids should be forwarded as soon as possible to our Toronto address and must reach us no later than Tuesday, August 25th. Late bids may be sent to us at the Nova Scotian Hotel, Halifax, N.S., Canada.
