Abbreviations and Definitions

Proof - Coins struck with highly polished dies that leave the coins with a mirror like finish.

Superb B.U. - Same as B.U., but without the usual signs of mint handling. Closely resemble proof coins.

B.U. - Brilliant Uncirculated. In new condition with mint lustre, but may show slight signs of mint handling.

UNC. - UNCIRCULATED. In new condition. Older coins may be dark or toned from oxidization.

AB. - ABOUT or almost as good as higher grade or classification.

X.F. - EXTREMELY FINE. Very slight signs of circulation

V.F. - VERY FINE. Shows wear on highest parts only, such as circlet of crown on Edward VII and George V issues. Leaves on wreath around head are sharp on Victoria Silver.

F. - FINE. Highest parts worn somewhat but yet desirable. All leaves show on wreath around head on Victoria silver. Circlet of crown on Edward VII and George V issues almost worn through.

V.G. - VERY GOOD. Considerably worn, but main features of design discernible and all lettering readable. Portion of leaves on wreath around head show on Victoria silver.

G. - GOOD. Badly worn but most of design and lettering discernible.

FR. - FAIR. Very badly worn, bent, scratched or otherwise damaged. Can be used as a space filler.

BR. - BRASS: CR. - CROSSFD: LG. - LARGE: M.L. - MAPLE LEAF: N. - NARROW;

NK. - NICKEL: RE-FNCR. - RE-ENGRAVED DATE: SM. - SMALL: ST. - STEEL: W. - WIDE.
