#### ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

- Proof - In new condition with mirror-like surface, struck with polished dies.  
Superb - Specially handled coins in new condition, the next grade to proof.  
B.U. - Brilliant Uncirculated. In new condition with original mint lustre, but may show signs of mint handling.  
Unc. - Uncirculated. In new condition. Older coins may be dark or toned from oxidization.  
V.F. - Very Fine. Shows only slight wear on higher parts of design, such as circlet of coronet on Victoria issues, and of crown on George V issues. Leaves on wreathed Victoria head are sharp.  
F. - Fine. More wear on higher parts than in VF. Lower left rim of circlet (Victoria) and circlet of George V Crown worn almost through. Leaves on wreathed head all show, but are not sharp.  
V.G. - Very Good. Much wear, but main features of design and legend clear. Little detail in circlet (Victoria), and only part of leaves showing in wreath.  
G. - Good. Badly worn but most of design and lettering discernible. 5¢ silver may be slightly bent.  
FR. - Fair. Very badly worn, bent, scratched or otherwise damaged. Can be used as a space filler.  
BR - Brass; CR - Crossed; LG - Large; ML - Maple Leaf; N - Narrow; NK - Nickel; RE-ENGR - Re-Engraved Date; SM - Small; ST - Steel; W - Wide.
