1959 CANADIAN COINAGE.

All orders for the Select Unc. Coins from bag shipments have been filled promptly. However, we regret to say that such has not been the case with the proof-like sets and silver dollars. As usual we placed large orders early in January and paid in advance for same. We advertised that delivery was expected in April, as we have always received all or a good portion of our orders in former years before the end of that month. However, this year for some unexplainable reason we did not receive a single coin until May 20th. The coins have now started to come through and in our opinion are the worst turned out by the Mint since the practice of selling specially handled coins at a premium was commenced some years ago. Many of the coins are marred by fingerprints and abrasions and we are selecting the better specimens and the discards will be sold at a discount. Those who ordered direct from the Mint are in the unfortunate position of accepting the coins 'as is' or returning at their own expense. The Mint offers no guarantee of quality. As is the case in this instance, a reputable dealer's nominal charge for his service is usually justified.

In view of the poor quality of the 1959 proof-like sets & silver dollars, as mentioned in May Bulletin, we had our Ottawa representative visit the Mint and discuss the matter with the officials. Prompt action was taken following the visit and the coinage is now coming through in excellent condition. Deliveries are still slow and we have only received a fraction of our order placed early in January. To make matters worse a considerable portion of the coins received earlier were rejected due to the imperfections. To those who have had to wait longer than usual for delivery, there is the consolation that they will receive choice coins.

AN OUTSTANDING OFFERING OF CANADIAN CHARTERED BANK NOTES. All are now obsolete, but these are negotiable. Many are rare and seldom available. Please make an alternate selection when ordering, as we anticipate a quick sell-out on the rarer notes.
