TERMS OF SALE

Auction lots will be available for viewing at the designated tables at the 1. Toronto International Coin Fair at all times prior to the auction.

Bids may be made in person at the auction, by mail or by telephone. Lots will be 2. sold to the highest bidder. Mail and telephone bids must reach us in Ottawa by Wednesday, March 21st, 1984. Answering service is available to take bids (24 hrs) at 1-613-235-1916. If there are identical bids, the earliest received shall take priority.

3. There is no "buyer's premium" in our auctions.

For mail and telephone bidders, we will attempt to obtain lots as cheaply as possible, by the following method: bids over estimate will be reduced to the estimate, or to 10% over the second highest bid, whichever amount is greater, and will then be increased against floor bids (if any) to the limit stated. Bids below estimate are quite in order, but will not be reduced. Bids below 50% of the estimate are respectfully declined, except that wosold lots from the "Devon" portions of the auction will be offered without reserve to floor bidders attending at the auction. Large and bulky lots may also, at the discretion of the auctioneers, be offered without reserve to those attending at the auction.

Estimates represent our best professional opinion of what lots are likely to sell 5. for on the open market. Most lots sell for between 70% and 120% of estimate: with a bid of 70% of estimate you have a fair chance of succeeding, with 120% you will

be quite likely to succeed.

6. Unlimited or "buy" bids are accepted, with the provision that the auctioneers have

complete discretion.

Floor bidding, and calculation of results of the auction, will be carried out in Canadian dollars. Bids expressed in other currencies will be converted to Canadian dollars at the applicable rate. Bids from customers with U.S. addresses, sent by mail or telephone, will be presumed to be in U.S. funds unless indication is made to the

contrary.

Mail bidders may return incorrectly described or misattributed lots for full credit within 15 days of the sale. There is no return privilege on books, except with our prior permission in writing. As consignors must be paid, late remittance for lots may be cause to negate all return privileges. ALL FLOOR SALES ARE FINAL, and no returns will be accepted from floor bidders (including those acting as agents for others) for any reason whatsoever.

Title to all lots remains with the auctioneer until paid for in full, but they are

held at the risk of the purchaser once the harmer has fallen.
