Answering service is available to take bids (24 hours) at 1-613-235-1916. If there are identical bids, the earliest received shall take priority.
3. There is no "buyer's premium" in our auctions.
4. We will attempt to obtain lots for bidders as cheaply as possible by the following method: bids over estimate will be reduced to the estimate, or to 10% over the second highest bid, whichever amount is greater. Bids below estimate are quite in order, but will not be reduced. Bids below 50% of estimate are respectfully declined. Please do not waste our time or yours by submitting ridiculous bids or bids below bullion content of items offered.
5. Estimates represent our best professional opinion of what lots are likely to sell for on the open market. Most lots sell for between 70% and 120% of estimate: with a bid of 70% you have a chance of succeeding, with 100% you will be likely to succeed and with 120% you have a very strong probability.
