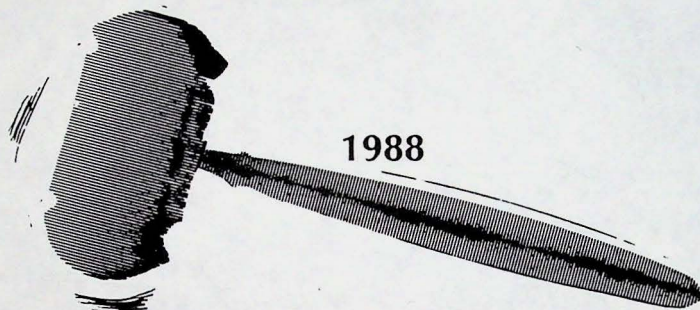

### Conduct of the Auction: Viewing of Lots

1. The two Auction Sales comprising AUCTION OTTAWA 1988 will be conducted in the Frobisher & Hudson Room of the Chimo Hotel, Joseph Cyr Blvd (adjacent to St. Laurent Shopping Centre), Ottawa, Ontario at 1 pm and 3 pm in the afternoon respectively on Sunday, September 18th, 1988. Auction lots will be available for viewing as follows: at LINCOLN HEIGHTS COIN & STAMP SHOP (Lincoln Heights Galleria, West End Ottawa, Carling Avenue at the Parkway) between 11 a.m. and 5 p.m. on SATURDAY, September 17th, 1988. Then, in the auction room from 11 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. on the day of the sale. No lots will be shown during the auction sessions. Arrangements may be made to view at our Offices or Banks, by appointment, prior to the auction.

### How to Bid

2. Bids may be made in person at the auction, by mail or by telephone. Lots will be sold to the highest bidder. Mail, telephone and telex bids must reach the applicable address by 5:00 p.m. on **Wednesday, September 14, 1988**. Answering machine service is also available to take bids (24 hours) at 1-613-232-GOLD (232-4653).

### Identical Bids

3. If there are identical bids, the earliest received shall take priority.

### No Buyer's Premium

4. There is no "buyer's premium" in either auction.

### Bidding Advances

5. **Nadin-Davis:** For mail and telephone bidders, we will attempt to obtain lots as cheaply as possible by the following method: bids over estimate will be reduced to the estimate, or to 10% over the second highest bid, whichever amount is greater, and will then be increased against floor bids (if any) to the limit stated. Bids below estimate are quite in order, but will not be reduced. **MAIL BIDS BELOW 50% OF THE ESTIMATE ARE RESPECTFULLY DECLINED.** The large and bulky lots contained in the auction may be offered without reserve to floor bidders at the discretion of the auctioneer.  
**Moore:** If there are two or more mail bids, the auctioneer will commence the bidding at approximately 10 percent above the second highest mail bid. If there is no floor bid for a lot, the highest mail bidder will receive the lot at the opening bid. If there is no mail bid for a lot, the auctioneer will commence the bidding at 50% of the estimate. If there is no floor bid at 50% of the estimate the auctioneer may, at his absolute discretion, either call for an opening bid from the floor or pass on to the next lot.
6. Advances in bidding are determined by the auctioneer, who has the right to refuse bids deemed not made in good faith. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the buyer. In the event of any dispute between bidders, the determination of the auctioneer is final.

### Reserved Lots

7. Reserved lots start at the consignor's reserve. Lots bid on and purchased by the owner or his agent are subject to the full commission.

### Meaning of Estimates

8. Estimates represent our best professional opinion of what lots are likely to sell for on the open market. Most lots sell for between 70% and 150% of estimate. With a bid of 70% of estimate you have a fair chance of succeeding; with a bid of 120% you will be very likely to succeed.

### Unlimited and Buy Bids, Bids from Minors

9. **Nadin-Davis:** Unlimited or "buy" bids are accepted, provided that the auctioneers have complete discretion.  
**Moore:** No unlimited or buy bids will be accepted. No bids from minors will be accepted unless guaranteed by the parent or guardian.

### Splitting-up and Combining of Lots

10. Lots from the same seller may be split up or combined at the auctioneer's absolute discretion.

### Currencies, Exchange Rates, Bids from Outside Canada

11. Floor bidding, and calculation of the results of this auction, will be carried out in **CANADIAN DOLLARS**. Bids expressed in other currencies will be converted to the operating currency at the applicable rate. Bids from customers with U.S. addresses, sent by mail or telephone, will be presumed to be in U.S. funds unless indication is made to the contrary.

#### Return Policies

12. Mail bidders may return incorrectly described or misattributed lots for full credit within 5 days of receipt, except that: as consignors must be paid, late remittance may be cause to negate return privileges, and absolutely no returns can be accepted for any reason after the expiry of 35 days from the date of the sale. ALL FLOOR SALES ARE FINAL, and no returns will be accepted from floor bidders (including those acting as agents for others) for any reason whatsoever.

#### Title and Risk of Lots

13. Title to all lots remains with the auctioneer until paid for in full, but they are held at the risk of the purchaser once the hammer has fallen.

#### Errors of Auctioneers and Bidders

14. Please check your bid sheet carefully. While we cheerfully correct our errors, we cannot be responsible for the mistakes of others.

#### Methods of Payment

15. **Nadin-Davis:** Successful mail bidders may pay by money order, check, VISA or MASTERCHARGE. A 3% handling charge will be added to all credit card payments.  
**Moore:** All lots must be paid for in full in Canadian funds or the equivalent. Terms are strictly cash or approved cheque. Credit card payments are not accepted.
16. For floor bidders, terms are strictly CASH unless prior arrangements have been made to the contrary.
17. All floor bidder accounts must be paid at the auction unless prior arrangements have been made. Mail and telephone accounts are due immediately. Interest at the rate of 2% per month is charged on all overdue accounts, and collection charges may be added where the services of a collection agency are required to collect monies owing.

#### Retail Sales Tax

18. Lots delivered in Ontario are subject to retail sales tax at the current rate (8%), unless an exemption certificate has been filed with us before the auction. Registration and actual postage will be charged on all lots shipped by us.

#### Shipping and Insurance

19. Unless otherwise instructed, lots purchased by postal bidders will be sent by registered mail to the successful purchaser. The limit of insurance on registered packages, however, is \$100 Cdn funds; for only a slightly higher charge we can use courier shipment with full insurance. Please indicate on your bid sheet if you wish courier service. All lots to be mailed to addresses not in Canada or the United States will be mailed only at the risk of the purchaser. We cannot obtain insurance on material sent by registered mail to other countries; therefore bidders must obtain their own insurance or assume the risk of non-delivery. Foreign bidders must supply full detailed shipping instructions and agree to all terms listed herein, before shipment will be made.

#### Effect of Bidding

20. Bidding in this auction constitutes acceptance of the foregoing terms of sale.

#### Rate of Sale

21. Lots will be sold at a rate of approximately 250 lots per hour.

#### Pick-up and Payment for Lots

22. LOTS MAY BE PAID FOR AND PICKED UP APPROXIMATELY 15 MINUTES AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF EACH SESSION, BUT NOT DURING THE AUCTION SESSIONS. ALL LOTS PURCHASED BY FLOOR BIDDERS MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE AUCTION ROOM ON THE DAY OF THE AUCTION. ANY LOTS NOT SO COLLECTED WILL BE SHIPPED AFTER PAYMENT OF INVOICE AT THE EXPENSE OF THE PURCHASER.

#### Prices Realized

23. Prices Realized will be published in a future auction catalogue or fixed price list.

#### Acts of God, etc.: Effect on Scheduling of Auction

24. The Auctioneers reserve the right to postpone this sale by auction of the property for a reasonable period of time as the result of any act of war, natural calamity or significant relevant event which, in the judgement of the auctioneer, reasonably excused, makes it inadvisable to hold the auction as scheduled.

Naturally the note is unsigned, and is "pasted up" on board to preserve it. There is a minor fold to the left side. An unique opportunity to own an important piece of maritime banking history (\$3500.00)

RARE "TEST NOTE" GROUP

We are pleased to offer no less than seven pieces of the extremely scarce test notes of the \$2 issue of 1954, signed Bouey-Rasminsky and Lawson-Bouey. It should be noted that the Bank of Canada makes no announcements regarding the issue of test notes, thus there is no special opportunity to preserve them at the time of issue. Rather, by chance just a few survive to be recognized much, much later. These seven notes (do not be fooled by their number, for very few others exist) were found among a small group of uncirculated notes which surfaced in an estate in Ottawa. It was purely fortuitous that they were recognized.

**Great Britain: Provincial Issues**

The following group of seven provincial bank notes is among the larger offerings ever seen at public auction in this country. All are typically VG-F, and soiled, but better examples are rarely seen as these notes circulated extensively in rural hands (and lands). Despite great scarcity they do not command particularly high prices and we encourage our clients to take advantage of this unusual opportunity to acquire some inexpensive and very rare notes. Some may care

to compare the values of these notes to those of comparable Canadian issues. Token collectors will note that the majority date from the same period as the Bank of England currency crisis which led to so many private issue metallic tokens.
