A VIEW OF THE "MARKET" - a short article answering some questions we are often asked.

There are as many different views on what will happen next in the coin market as there are people. No-one really knows, for anyone who did would be able to make an infinite amount of money and retire! We are often asked what should be held, what should be sold. Our general rule of thumb is this: when the rest of the world is lining up to buy, it's time to sell. When everyone is selling, it's time to buy.

We've not done too badly in the

last year, despite it being a year when many coin dealers lost large amounts of money. One thing we've consistently done is maintained a market in things which everyone was trying to get rid of. When, last year, Newfoundland coins were as cheap as I can remember, we bought them in the hundreds, including the scarce dates. Now we're able to offer them at fantastic savings over competitors' prices!

These countries are presently "hot" and we can predict that eventually there will be a market collapse: Norway, Korea, Japan, Venezuela, a few others. We don't hang onto coins from these countries, as we don't want to be left holding the baby!

These countries are currently very "cold", and long-term appreciation might best be achieved by purchasing shrewdly in their better coinage: Ireland, Denmark, Australia, New Zealand, Germany, Netherlands. Some of these have seen a serious collapse in the last few years.

When the world is lining up to sell, it's time to buy! Choice 1967 dollars, cased proof dollars, PL sets - these have recently seen major price revisions. They may go a little cheaper, but many people now want to sell. We are buying, and would counsel our investment-oriented customers to seriously consider these commodities

What's consistent? For steady growth or stable market conditions, we recommend the following areas of collecting: Choice ancients, scarce numismatic literature, U.S. gold and some U.S. type, classic rarities. It's a great time to buy British, given the sad plight of the pound! But no market is manipulation-proof.

Should I sell my silver today or wait for it to go up? If I knew the answer to this one, I could retire by the end of the year! Bullion investors have much in common with well-informed bettors at a "straight" racetrack!
