

Auctions

Our auctions are held regularly, at least twice each year, at the Toronto International Coin Fair. Usual dates are in March and November. Other auction dates may be set as needs arise.

Commission rates are negotiable for large or special consignments, but are generally as follow:

Bulk lots, numismatic literature, lots up to \$100 - 25%

Lots over \$100 to \$500 - 15%. Lots over \$500 - 10%.

Prices referred to above are selling prices.

Settlement checks are issued within 45 days of the sale.

Cash advances can be provided up to 50% of the estimated value of lots consigned, on the strict understanding that lots are sold entirely without reserve. The commission rate in such cases is 2½% higher than for lots consigned without advance. Advances constitute no guarantee whatsoever that the lots consigned will realize sufficient to cover the advance.

Monthly Price Lists and Auction Catalogs

We issue at least 10 fixed price lists per year, in addition to the catalogs for at least two major auctions. Annual subscription is \$10 Canadian in Canada, \$10 U.S. elsewhere in the world. Catalogs are always mailed first class. Orders receive prompt attention and are usually shipped within eight hours of receipt.

Selling Your Coins

We spend many thousands of dollars each week buying collections and nice individual items from collectors whose tastes have changed, from estates, and from other dealers. Our needs are worldwide, including Canada and Newfoundland, world gold, Crowns and minors, ancient coins, and tokens and medals. Please contact us when you think of selling; we will travel to view where your holdings warrant and otherwise we can usually do business most satisfactorily by mail.

Want List Service

We maintain an active file of want lists in all numismatic areas and read through them regularly. If you desire particular items, please feel welcome to let us know. We also suggest that you update your list regularly so that we do not take your time unnecessarily by offering items that you have already acquired.
