Rolls of 1968 coins, especially the .500 silver 10¢ and 25¢ have been in heavy demand. This no doubt is due to the intended change to pure nickel coins later this year, and the anticipated low mintage of both denominations.

Toronto banks will not supply more than one or two rolls of 1968 coins to collectors or dealers. Bags of 1968 coins, although in the banks' vaults, are not available to numismatists.

We are now accepting advance orders for 1968 proof-like sets and dollars. As announced earlier, these sets will contain 5 nickel coins and the 1¢ in copper and should prove to be very popular. This issue will be Canada's first set in pure nickel, the start of a complete new series in our decimal coinage. Both the \$1 and 50¢ coins will be reduced in size.

The mint has promised delivery of our orders for sets and dollars for early April. Those ordering from us will receive their shipments on a first come first served basis, as soon as deliveries are made to us.

At a date not yet announced, the mint will release the 1968 dollar in a special presentation case to mark the 60th anniversary of the Royal Canadian Mint.

As you are aware, for the last several months we have not published our Bulletin. This was due to the relocation of Canada Coin Exchange to our new Montreal headquarters. As well, we have gone through a very difficult period arising from the merger with World Wide Corp. of Montreal. However, we feel now that we have overcome all of these problems and we will be in a position to resume our regular retail business.

From 1965 until recently, there has been a general decline from the peak prices of coins at that time; moderate in the case of our numismatic items and very severe in the speculative rounds and proof like sets, etc., as well, several other factors including tight money, the stock market recession, etc. However, we have noticed recently a turn around and a gradual beginning of climbing market. Therefore, we can honestly recommend that now is the right time to buy at the right price, especially proof like material. There are several reasons this type of material is a sound investment. The Canadian Proof Like set, until 1968, were silver and of very low mintages compared to many of the world proof sets, all of which contain the Silver Dollar. In some cases, the cost is below the mint issue price. With Canada still issuing Commemorative dollar coins, the Silver dollar series is, as always, very popular and there has been a noticeable increase in the purchase of this series by dealers in Europe and Asia. We honestly feel there will be an increase in price of the Commemorative and type dollars, of at least 25%, within the current year.

Since the teletype system was started in Canada, two months ago, it has shown that the dealers have no stock of this material. Between dealers, the price of most commemorative dollars have jumped 20% in two months and the demands are heavy.

We are also, for the first time, enclosing our price list on military medals. We believe we have the largest stock in Canada.

We hope the delay in the publishing of our Bulletin has not caused you any inconvenience. At any rate, our Bulletin should appear on a regular basis now, and with our expanded facilities, we hope that we will have something for everyone.

"FLASH"

We have just received our stock of the new Canadian \$20.00 bills from the Bank of Canada. These notes represent the first change in our paper currency since 1954 and the first multi-coloured note that Canada has issued since the old chartered bank issue in 1935. They are most striking in appearance, the predominant colour being dark green on both sides. On the obverse side there is a completely new portrait of the Queen at the right, and a colourful Canadian Coat of Arms at the left on a pale orange background. The serial numbers are now printed in Red and Blue and the signatures in Dark Green. The new legal clause now reads "This Note is Legal Tender" instead of "Will pay to the bearer on demand". The picture on the reverse depicts lake and mountain scenery with a few swirls engraved on each side. The type of paper used is thinner and crispier than previous issues. This bill is very modernistic and yet retains the quality and taste one would expect in Canadian currency. We feel this new series will delight the Paper Money Collectors in general.

We have a fairly limited number available and at \$22.50 per note, we will sell no more than five per customer, on a first come, first served basis.
