Presented to Gen. Andrew Jackson, Jan. 15, 1828 at a reception and dinner given in his honor by the citizens of New Orleans. J. H. Hamilton, Samuel Allen and Thaddeus Phelps were present as delegates from New York to help elect Jackson president. Mr. Hamilton presented the medal, "In the name of the Corporation of the City of New York." For a full account see *Virginia Advocate* Feb. 9, 1828. In original red morocco case inscribed in gold letters MAJ. GEN. ANDREW JACKSON. 1827.
